TAKEAWAYS

- Patients should wear a face covering or facemask
- HCWs should wear masks and eye protection
- HIGH RISK exposure = 14 days quarantine
 - Will depend on circumstances for household contacts
 - » If able, may work remotely
- LOW RISK exposure = Return to work
 - » Monitor for any symptoms
 - » Keep wearing a mask and eye protection
- Return to work guidance varies depending on patient population risk, HCW risks or critical work shortage
